

Taipei, Taiwan - June 02, Computex 2010, Show Daily **Amigo Manufactures 11N/3G/4G/WiMax Broadband Routers to Secure Internet Access** **Anywhere, Anytime**

Amigo Technology Inc., the Taiwan-based network device maker, has been able to successfully establish its product and solutions in the wireless market. Mainly focused on OEM/ODM business, Amigo products devices such as routers, adapters, switches modems and even media players. For COMPUTEX TAIPEI 2010, Amigo management wants visitors to open their eyes to the unique functionality and quality of a series of wireless routers, wireless USB adapters and a media player that the company produces.

"Always On" Internet, Amigo combines both 3G/4G(WiMAX) broadband and WiFi in one low-cost unit that can also connect to traditional networks as a dial-up replacement option. "The 802.11n Multifunction Pocket Router is the product that we think has greatest market potential in a society that is becoming more and more mobile" said Thomas Chou, President of Amigo. "What the gadget mainly does is that it allows users to create an Ethernet or wireless office or home network so that they can share wireless Internet connections. By the same token, users can also share files on individual mobile devices, such as notebooks and WiFi phones, as well as plugged in peripherals, such as printers and webcams."

Small size and support for portable batteries and car batteries mean the mobile server router is easy to carry, making it even more appealing to mobile users, according to Fupo Teng, Assistant Manger of Amigo's FAE Department. "Small size is a big plus for the router, and multiple power source options enable users to use the device anywhere they go," said Teng.

Closely related to the above-mentioned mobile router is the 802.11n Multi-function Server Router, which is bigger in size but with the desirable added value of downloading.

"In addition to providing all the functions of a regular wireless router, the 802.11n Multi-function Server Router can also be set up to download data from the Internet and then store it in a plugged-in USB. Users can use the Media Player from the Internet and then store them in the plugged-in USB. Users can use the Media Player from DLNA to play multimedia files on the USB without having to do any additional setup," said Teng.

Moreover, Amigo has plans to develop WiMAX products, including adapters and routers, as for WiMAX, the related technologies are not controlled by just a few companies and Taiwan is an excellent environment for WiMAX development. Amigo is working aggressively to strengthen related product lines in 2010.

Amigo will also showcase a media player at the show that is capable of playing online videos from internet websites such as YouTube. The device can output content to a TV, and can be tailored to play video from specific Internet sites. We can support customers across a wide range of needs.
